simply unbox and install your new slat wall panels

Skip the prep work! We've taken care of the finishing touches, so you don't have to. These panels come pre-finished for a beautiful look right out of the box.



Cut / Trim (as needed):

Need to cut your panels to fit your space? No problem! Use a sharp saw to cut across the slats and a craft knife to cut the felt backing lengthwise.

Important note: Before moving on to step 2, be sure to pre-cut any openings for outlets, switches, or other features you may need.

Glue It (optional):

Prep the glue by cutting the tip and insert it into the dispenser. Then, spread the construction adhesive in even strips directly onto the felt backing of the panel, leaving a 2-inch gap around the edges to prevent squeezing out during application.



Secure It with Screws:

Once glued, put the panel into place and screw the black drywall screws directly through the felt and into the wall to ensure a secure hold. Remember, the panels interlock, so the screw holes will be hidden behind the slat of the previous panel.

Please note: Once all panels have been installed, if you purchased our coordinating slat wall end pieces, now is the time to install them. Simply cut to size and secure with finishing nails or construction adhesive for a flawless finish.
